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**BUFFALO AND ERIE COUNTY GREENWAY STANDING COMMITTEE TO MEET  
NOVEMBER 27 FOR A STATUS UPDATE OF OPEN PROJECT AWARDS**

BUFFALO—The next meeting of the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing Committee will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, November 27, at the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo, 726 Exchange Street, Suite 525, Buffalo, NY 14210. The meeting is open to the public.

The meeting agenda includes a status update of the open Greenway project grant awards.

The committee receives funds from New York Power Authority as part of the settlement agreement related to the 50-year federal license received by NYPA for the Niagara Power Project in 2007. During the term of the license, the Buffalo and Erie County Standing Committee will receive \$2 million a year. It is composed of one representative from Erie County, the City of Buffalo, Buffalo Olmsted Parks Conservancy and NYPA.
