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**BUFFALO AND ERIE COUNTY GREENWAY STANDING COMMITTEE TO MEET
DECEMBER 19 FOR APPROVAL OF A GRANTS MANAGEMENT SERVICES
AGREEMENT**

BUFFALO—The next meeting of the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing Committee will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 19, 2017 at Phillips Lytle Grover Conference Room, One Canalside, 125 Main Street, Buffalo, NY 14203-2887. The meeting is open to the public.

The meeting agenda includes approval of a Grants Management Services Agreement with the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo.

The committee receives funds from New York Power Authority as part of the settlement agreement related to the 50-year federal license received by NYPA for the Niagara Power Project in 2007. During the term of the license, the Buffalo and Erie County Standing Committee will receive \$2 million a year. It is composed of one representative from Erie County, the City of Buffalo, Buffalo Olmsted Parks Conservancy and NYPA.
