**BUFFALO AND ERIE COUNTY GREENWAY STANDING COMMITTEE
TO MEET APRIL 5 FOR ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDS OF
SUBMITTED PROJECT APPLICATIONS**

BUFFALO – A follow-up meeting of the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing Committee will be held at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 5 at the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo, 726 Exchange Street, Suite 525, Buffalo, NY 14210. The meeting is open to the public.

The meeting agenda includes announcements of awards on applications under consideration in the current round of requests.

The Committee receives funds from New York Power Authority (NYPA) as part of the settlement agreement related to the 50-year federal license received by NYPA for the Niagara Power Project in 2007. During the term of the license, the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing will receive \$2 million a year. It is composed of one representative from Erie County, the City of Buffalo, Buffalo Olmsted Parks Conservancy and NYPA.
