On behalf of the Niagara Greenway Ecological Standing Committee (GESC) I am pleased to enclose a check for \$235,225 to initiate the first year of the "Niagara Riparian Restoration Program—Phase II." As was discussed and agreed upon during the development of the project proposal, the GESC will release additional project funds as needed to execute the site specific projects after the sites have been scoped by your staff and approved by the GESC. It is necessary that you provide the GESC with a detailed project work scope and budget for each of the restoration sites for a given year as a prerequisite to receiving funds.

Since it is a multi-year project, the GESC also requests that you provide a progress report and meet with the committee annually at the end of each year. Pending satisfactory progress in achieving program goals, funding for the subsequent year will be released.
